Q.

Night Length

I have been growing orchids for about two years, and have rebloomed evergreen dendrobiums and oncidiums with no problem. My cattleyas are in the same growing area - a large south-facing window where the light is also supplemented by a Wonderlite, especially in winter. None of my cattleyas have rebloomed. I realize lack of light is the usual reason for failure to flower, but I'm puzzled by my success with the dendrobiums if light is the factor. Could it be light duration? I do reduce the duration in winter but perhaps not enough. The area gets warm temperatures, rarely below 62 F on winter nights. — Aline M. Kuntz

A.

Since you have pre-empted my first guess, which would be lack of light (it sounds like they receive plenty), I would then suspect that your plants are receiving insufficient day-night differential. Especially if you have selected plants that bloom in winter into spring, long nights are particularly necessary for blooming. Unless the plants receive at least 10 to 12 uninterrupted hours of night, they may not bloom. Lack of uninterrupted darkness may be the key. If the room in which they are grown has even so much as a reading light close to the plants, it will interrupt their night and provide a short-night treatment. The warmer winter nights may also be a contributory factor, but a minor one. — *Ned Nash*

JUDGES CORNER – AOS Awards

September 2015

I know how confusing the American Orchid Society award system seems to be. Add the Taiwan Orchid Growers Association (TOGA), Australian Orchid Society (AOC) and other countries as well and the label on your new orchid can look like a well-used passport.

Let's focus just on the AOS award system. Explanations of AOS awards can be found on its website at www.aos.org. From there, click on the "Judging" link, then click on "Judging Handbook". The entire handbook is public information. Once there, sections VI and VII explain all of the awards and then explain the point system which is used by all judges at AOS sanctioned events. It even shows all of the scoresheets.

AOS awards are divided into "Awards for Individual Plants", "Awards for Display of Plants, Flowers and Educational Material" and "Special Annual Awards". If there a point count required for an award, it will be 100-points. Some awards do not require pointing and are awarded based on the judging team agreement.

PLANT AWARDS

HCC (Highly Commended Certificate) - 75 to 79 points on the Flower Quality Scoresheet.

AM (Award of Merit) - 80 to 89 points on the Flower Quality Scoresheet.

FCC (First Class Certificate) - 90 to 100 points on the Flower Quality Scoresheet.

CCM (Certificate of Cultural Merit) - 80 to 89 points on the Cultural Merit Scoresheet.

CCE (Certificate of Cultural Excellence) - 90 to 100 points on the Cultural Merit Scoresheet.

CHM (Certificate of Horticultural Merit) - 80 to 100 points on the Horticultural Merit Scoresheet.

CBR (Certificate of Botanical Recognition) - no scoring; two-thirds affirmative of the judging team.

JC (**Judges' Commendation**) – no scoring; 75% affirmative of the judging team.

AD (Award of Distinction) – no scoring; awarded unanimously by the judging team.

AQ (Award of Quality) - no scoring; awarded unanimously by the judging team.

EXHIBIT AWARDS

AOS Show Trophy - 80 to 100 points on the Show Trophy Scoresheet.

Silver Certificate - 85 to 89 points on the Show Trophy Scoresheet.

Gold Certificate - 90 to 100 points on the Show Trophy Scoresheet.

Educational Exhibit Certificate - 80 to 100 points on the Educational Scoresheet.

Artistic Certificate - no scoring; awarded unanimously by the judging team.
